



Robert Trever Griffin

April 9, 1930 - November 11, 2017

Robert Trever Griffin, 87, of Highland Village, Texas passed away peacefully on November 11, 2017 at Rambling Oaks Courtyard with a clear mind and loving heart. Robert was born April 9, 1930 in Akron, Ohio to Oscar Trever Griffin and Myrtle Lee (Smith) Griffin. He graduated from Akron High School in 1947 and briefly attended college before being inducted into the U.S. Army in 1950. Robert served in the Korean War and also in the Army Reserve (1950-56) and achieved the rank of Corporal during his military career as well as being awarded the Purple Heart for wounds sustained while serving his country. Robert "Bob" was an avid bowler and achieved many awards and made lifelong friends with his teammates over the years. Bob was a sportsman as well, playing in a fast pitch softball league over many years and lots of weekends waterskiing with family and friends. Bob was an avid reader and loved to study history and instilled a love of learning in his children along with an extensive library filled with classics and the best novels of the period. Bob was a member of the Mensa Society which no doubt explained his love for bridge and other games of skill and strategy.

Bob was a loving husband, father, and companion whose travels ranged from Ohio to Colorado to Europe and many points in between. Bob settled in the suburbs of Dallas, Texas in the early 1960's and remained in the area for most of his life except for a 5-year period where he and his wife Diane resided in Roswell, New Mexico. Bob's professional career led him to mechanical engineering and he became an expert in the steel building business with successful stays at both Luminator and Delta Steel Buildings that sustained his livelihood for many years. The couple's residence in New Mexico enabled Bob to accept a position working on design and quality assurance for a commercial bus manufacturing firm with clients such as the City of Chicago and other municipalities. Bob is survived by wife, Sharon Diane Griffin, daughter Kelly DeLoache Burke, son Michael Trever Griffin and his wife Debbie, daughter Terry Lynn Kelly and her husband Mark, daughter Jeryl Hejl, grandchildren Samuel Burke, Laine Griffin, and Noah Griffin; and many dear friends and relations.
